

## Plumbing Now Tips

### Tip #1

Learn where your Main Water Shut Off is and how to use it. Make sure you have a quick closing valve installed. It can help in a panic!

### Tip #2

Avoid rainy day surprises; check your sump pump to make sure it is in working order. Keep debris out of the pit. This can save from flooding.

### Tip #3

Washing machine hose failure is a major cause of flooding in homes. You can now have stainless steel braided hoses installed, instead of rubber hoses. It always happens when you are not home... Murphy's Law!

### Tip #4

Did you know that if you don't have a siphon flush tank ball cock in your toilet you might be drinking toilet tank water? Ewww! Check it out.

### Tip #5

Water Hammer. This annoying bang when you turn off the faucet or when your washing machine shuts off. This is costing you money. That bang is damaging your plumbing system.

### Tip #6

Having a leaky faucet and toilet tank fixed or replaced can save you money on water. An average leak can waste up to 1,000 gallons of water per month.

### Tip #7
